Mid-term Goals for this PH SSC Taskforce *(2020 & 2021)*

1. Continue to **invite interested mayors** in the Philippines to be part of this national movement for Smarter and Sustainable Cities (to reach **100 mayors by end 2021**)
 - a) Identify interested ecosystem partners from Smart Cities Council (SCC)
 - b) From the ecosystem partners of the ASEAN Smart Cities Network
 - c) By the Governments (US, UK and Australia) & International Orgs (e.g. World Bank)

2. Digitally Twinned Smart Cities – with other cities in ASEAN and Globally (2020 & 2021)

- a) Extending the current ecosystem between Cauayan City with Singapore and Indonesia*
- b) In 2019 – identify the top 10 cities around the world*
 - Capital Cities (Manila with those in ASEAN, e.g. Jakarta, KL, Bangkok, etc)*
 - Smart Provinces (and States) – in ASEAN Countries & Globally*
- c) From 2020, facilitate the twinning of the cities and provinces with participating cities*
