

#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



### <u>Mid-term Goals for this PH SSC Taskforce</u> (2020 & 2021)

- 1. Continue to **invite interested mayors** in the Philippines to be part of this national movement for Smarter and Sustainable Cities (to reach **100 mayors by end 2021**)
  - a) Identify interested ecosystem partners from Smart Cities Council (SCC)
  - b) From the ecosystem partners of the ASEAN Smart Cities

    Network
  - c) By the Governments (US, UK and Australia) & International Orgs (e.g. World Bank)

# 2. Digitally Twinned Smart Cities – with other cities in ASEAN and Globally (2020 & 2021)

- a) Extending the current ecosystem between Cauayan City with Singapore and Indonesia
- b) In 2019 identify the top 10 cities around the world
  - Capital Cities (Manila with those in ASEAN, e.g. Jakarta, KL, Bangkok, etc)
  - Smart Provinces (and States) in ASEAN Countries & Globally
- c) From 2020, facilitate the twinning of the cities and provinces with participating cities
